- *Psalm 139:23-24*

1. Repentance must be treasured

Because of...

- **What repentance is (Matthew 4:17)**
Repentance is an invitation from God
- **What repentance means literally**
- **What repentance does**
 - Brings alignment
 - Brings abundant life (Psalm 139:24) (Romans 12:2)

2. Repentance must be timely

- Repentance is not sporadic
- Repentance is a “signpost on the path of discipleship” (John 13:5-10)

3. Repentance must be thorough (Psalm 139: 23-24a)

A repentant prayer invites the Father to “inspect all 4 corners of the room of our life”

4 Corners of Sin

1. Sins of volition (Proverbs 4:23)

2. Sins of relation (Matthew 5:23-24, Matthew 6:14-15)

3. Sins of commission (I John 3:4, Ephesians 4:29)

4. Sins of omission (James 4:17)
