SEPTEMBER 13, 2020

READ

- Luke's gospel from 4:14-9:50 now focuses on the period of popularity for the Lord Jesus, when He ministered in and around the region of Galilee.
- Read Luke 9:1-9 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Who are the "twelve" referred to in verse 1 (see 6:12-16)?
- What does Jesus commission the twelve to do (9:1-2)?
- What instructions does He give them (9:3-5)?
- What perplexes King Herod? Why is he perplexed (9:6-9)?

APPLY

- The mission of the 12 disciples represents Christ's priorities for His people. How do your priorities align with the Lord's priorities? How do your church's priorities align with the Lord's priorities?
- Herod asks about Jesus, "Who is this about whom I hear such things?" How would you answer that question for someone today who does not know Jesus?
