## LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

**SEPTEMBER 20, 2020**

### **READ**

- Luke's gospel from 4:14-9:50 now focuses on the period of popularity for the Lord Jesus, when He ministered in and around the region of Galilee.
- Read Luke 9:10-17 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

### **EXAMINE**

- What is the context of this account: what has gone on previously?
- Jesus desires private time with his 12 disciples, but what happens (9:10-11)? What do you learn about the Lord Jesus through His response to the circumstances?
- What dilemma occurs in the story (9:12-13)? How do the disciples respond? How does Jesus respond?
- How does Jesus address the dilemma (9:14-17)? What lessons does He convey to His disciples through His solution to the problem?

### **APPLY**

- The twelve had just experienced a successful spiritual mission yet didn't have faith at the time when food was needed for so many. Why is it that followers of Christ often lack faith when tested even when we have experienced the power of God time after time? In what way do you identify with the disciples in this story?
- The Lord Jesus overflows with grace and generosity. How have you experienced His grace and generosity in your life? When has He been gracious and generous when you know you did nothing to deserve it?
