LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

OCTOBER 4, 2020

READ

- Luke's gospel from 4:14-9:50 now focuses on the period of popularity for the Lord Jesus, when He ministered in and around the region of Galilee.
- Read Luke 9:28-36 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Eight days pass between 20-27 and verse 28, specifically after "these sayings." What had Jesus revealed in vv 26-27 that relates to 28-36?
- Observe what happens in verses 28-36. How would you retell this account in your own words?
- Why did Moses and Elijah appear with Jesus (think back on the opinions people held about Jesus in 9:8 and 9:19)? Why did Peter want to build 3 tents?
- Many in Luke 9 have been asking, "Who is Jesus?" Now God the Father gives His answer. What does He reveal about Jesus (9:35)?

APPLY

- What do you learn about the Lord Jesus from this passage?
- In what ways do you identify with the disciples in this story? What lessons for disciples of all time are found in this account?
