



# THE KING'S MISSION

## LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

**OCTOBER 11, 2020**

### **READ**

- Luke's gospel from 4:14-9:50 now focuses on the period of popularity for the Lord Jesus, when He ministered in and around the region of Galilee.
- Read Luke 9:37-45 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

### **EXAMINE**

- Looking back over Luke 9, we see that Jesus has been revealed in glory to be God's chosen Son (28-36), and has been revealed as the true King (10-17). The disciples have confessed their faith in Him and seen Him do many amazing things.
- Looking at 9:37-45, what surprising things do you discover about the disciples – things that we might conclude they should not be dealing with?
- What was the problem with the young boy, and how does Jesus respond?
- What news did Jesus share with the disciples, and how do they respond?

### **APPLY**

- Some say faith is a "leap in the dark," but that doesn't square with the biblical presentation of faith. What kinds of things had the disciples seen about Jesus up to this point to build their faith in Him? Why did they struggle to believe?
- When you struggle to believe in Jesus or entertain doubts about His character or work, think back on what He has revealed about Himself through His Word and work in your life. What can you call to mind to stimulate your faith in the Lord Jesus?
