READ

- Luke's gospel from 4:14-9:50 now focuses on the period of popularity for the Lord Jesus, when He ministered in and around the region of Galilee.
- Read Luke 9:18-27 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- What is the occasion of this text: where are Jesus and His disciples?
- What two questions does Jesus ask His disciples, and how do they respond (18-20)?
- What does Jesus predict will happen to him (22)? What does this reveal about "the Christ" (20-21)? Why does Jesus not want His identity to be spread by His disciples?
- What commands does Jesus issue to "all" disciples (23)?
- What motivators does Jesus give for obedience (see all the statements that follow "For" in 24-26)?

APPLY

- Answering the question "Who is Jesus?" is one of the most important we can answer. You've seen what Peter and the Apostles answered. How would you answer this question?
- What does it look like to practically "deny yourself, take up your cross daily and follow Jesus"? Can you think of some examples from daily life?
