



THE KING'S MISSION

LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

DECEMBER 6, 2020

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 10:17-24 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- When the 72 return to Jesus from their mission, what do they report to Him (17)?
- How does Jesus both affirm their work (18-19) and offer a needed corrective (20)?
- For what does Jesus praise His Father (21)? What does it mean for Jesus to do this "in the Holy Spirit"?
- What do you learn about Jesus, especially His understanding of His identity and role in verse 22? What do you learn about God the Father?
- What blessing does Jesus speak over His disciples in verse 23-24?

APPLY

- There are many blessings that bring us joy in daily life, yet if we make those things our consistent sources of joy, we will be disappointed. How is it risky to place our joy in our work, family or even ministry? Why is our eternal security a constantly reliable source of joy?
- "[No one knows who] the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him" (Luke 10:22). How does this truth produce humility in you? How does it bring glory to God alone (and not people)?
