## LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

**DECEMBER 13, 2020**

### **READ**

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 10:25-37 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

### **EXAMINE**

- This familiar account begins with a "test" for the Lord Jesus. What do you learn about the man who is speaking with Jesus: what is his background and position in life? What is his motive for approaching Jesus?
- What is the great commandment that the man quotes to Jesus? What is the Lord's direction to the man? How does the man respond?
- Retell the parable in verses 30-35.
- How does Jesus apply the parable to the lawyer (36-37)?

### **APPLY**

- What have you learned from this account? How might the Holy Spirit want you to respond?
- Jesus told the lawyer to "go and do likewise" what the good Samaritan did. How might we today live like the good Samaritan? What opportunities are before you to "go and do likewise"?
