LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

JANUARY 10, 2020

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 11:5-13 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- The Lord Jesus continues (from Luke 11:1-4) His emphasis on prayer by giving a real-life example (5-8). What are the basic points of that example?
- How does Jesus relate this example to the prayer life of His disciples (9-10)?
- In verses 11-12 Jesus gives another example that relates to prayer. What is the example He gives?
- What does Jesus teach about God the Father in verse 13 to encourage His disciples to pray?

APPLY

- Review from Luke 11:1-4 – What are some of the prayer errors that we can fall into, which Pastor Sam preached about on Sunday, January 3rd?
- Jesus wants us to trust God the Father. Do you think of God as a Father? How do you typically think of that term "father"? What images or thoughts come to mind?
- God gives the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him. What is the benefit of having the Holy Spirit?
