LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

MARCH 7, 2021

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 12:1-7 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- What is the context immediately before Luke 12? What had Jesus been doing?
- Jesus has one main warning about the Pharisees of His day. What is the warning He gives His disciples (12:1)?
- What truth did Jesus share with his disciples to sober them up to the danger of the Pharisees (12:2-3)?
- Jesus speaks about fear in verses 4-7. What type of fear must His disciples not have? What type of fear must they cultivate in their lives?
- What does Jesus reveal about His Father to His disciples (12:5-7)?

APPLY

- What circumstances in your life right now cause you to feel fear? Where do you see fear evidenced in our country right now? How can you battle those fears with the truths in Luke 12:1-7?
- Often, we interpret bad times, or the trouble we are caused by bad people, to indicate that God doesn't love us. What kinds of situations sometimes tempt you to think God doesn't love you? How does Luke 12:1-7 instruct you to respond to God in those times?
