



THE KING'S MISSION

LUKE CHAPTERS 9-13

MARCH 14, 2021

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 12:8-12 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Look back at Luke 12:4-7 and discover again who Jesus is speaking about. Looking at 12:8-12, who else does Jesus teach about?
- What does Jesus say is the right thing for His followers to do when others ask if they follow Jesus (12:8-9)? What will happen if they do not do this?
- Verse 10, particularly the "blasphemy against the Holy Spirit," can be a source of confusion or even worry. Look back at Luke 11:14-20 to shed light on the sin of "blasphemy against the Spirit." What was the sin Jesus addressed in Luke 11:14-20? How does it relate to Luke 12:10?
- What future situation does Jesus say His followers will face? What is His promise to them when that happens (11-12)?

APPLY

- Like the Pharisees and Lawyers united against Jesus in Luke 11:53, so Jesus's people face opposition for submitting to Him today. Where do you see persecution of Christians around the world? In what situations might you face potential persecution for following Jesus in your everyday life?
- Do you know anyone who has expressed fear that they've blasphemed against the Holy Spirit? How would you help a friend, from the Bible, if he or she came to you with that fear?
- Where do you have the opportunity to give witness to others that you follow Jesus? Think through your opportunities, and ask others to support you and pray for boldness and wisdom to speak aloud for Jesus to those you daily come in contact with.
