The Gospel of Luke Chapters 15-19

JULY 11, 2021

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 15:11-32 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Before examining the story in 11-32, look again at 15:1-2. What is the context Jesus is in, and what leads to him sharing the story?
- What do you learn about the younger son in this parable?
- What do you learn about the older son in this parable?
- What do you learn about the father?
- What happens at the end of the parable, and what does that imply about those listening (see 15:2)?

APPLY

- With whom do you identify in this story of the father with two sons, and why?
- What does the Father in the story reveal about the heart of God the Father, and how do those revelations challenge or encourage you in your relationship with God?

Take time to write out below a prayer of praise, confession of sins and/or requests based on this passage:
