

# The King's Calling

The Gospel of Luke Chapters 15-19

**JULY 18, 2021**

## **READ**

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 16:1-13 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

## **EXAMINE**

- Jesus teaches God's perspective about wealth by using an example of a bad manager (1-8). What do you learn about the bad manager? How does his example relate to the Christian life (see the end of verse 8)?
- What does Jesus teach about wealth in verse 9?
- What does Jesus say about being "faithful" in verses 10-12?
- What two "masters" can a person potentially serve (13)? What does Jesus reveal about serving those two masters?

## **APPLY**

- What are some ways a Christian can "make friends" by using "unrighteous wealth" to make an eternal impact?
- How does this passage challenge you personally in terms of how you currently handle wealth? In what areas are you in line with Jesus's teaching? In what areas will you commit to grow in handling wealth for the glory of God?
