

The King's Calling

The Gospel of Luke Chapters 15-19

AUGUST 15, 2021

READ

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 17:11-19 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Where does Luke locate Jesus in this account (11)? What is the significance of the setting (refer to Luke 9:51)?

What do you learn about the 10 men who come and appeal to Jesus (12-13)?

- How would you describe what occurs in verse 14?
- How do the 10 men respond to what Jesus does for them? What makes the "one" unique and stand out from the other 9?

APPLY

- Think of the effects of leprosy on a person socially, physically, emotionally and spiritually. In what ways can leprosy serve as a helpful illustration of being lost in sin?
- Think of the one leper's gratitude toward Jesus. What do you have from Jesus for which to be grateful? Would the Lord Jesus characterize you as a person of gratitude?
