



# The King's Calling

## The Gospel of Luke Chapters 15-19

**OCTOBER 10, 2021**

### **READ**

- Luke's gospel from 9:51-19:44 begins with Jesus determined to go to Jerusalem and culminates with His triumphal entry to the city. This section could be summarized as "the Road to the Cross."
- Read Luke 19:1-10 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

### **EXAMINE**

- What do we know about Zacchaeus, the man Jesus encounters passing through Jericho?
- Why do people grumble when Jesus goes to Zacchaeus' home? (7)
- What do you think leads Zacchaeus to give half of his goods to the poor and restore fourfold what he had defrauded? (8)
- What does it mean that "the Son of Man came to seek and save the lost?" (10)

### **APPLY**

- What does Jesus' treatment of Zacchaeus (a man that many disliked) teach us about how we should treat people?
- What does Zacchaeus' generosity show us about what it means to follow Jesus?
- Jesus came on a mission to "seek and save the lost." If you're a Christian, someone who was once lost and is now found, what is your role in this mission?

### **PRAY**

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
