



# THE KING'S CONFIRMATION

Luke Chapters 20-22

## READ

- Read Luke 20:27-47 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

## EXAMINE

- What do you know about the Sadducees? (27)
- Why do you think that the Sadducees chose this question to ask Jesus when they confronted Him? (28-33)
- What do you think is Jesus' point when He says that God is "not God of the dead, but of the living"? (38)
- What claim is Jesus making about Himself in verses 41-44?
- Why does Jesus warn His disciples about the scribes? (45-47)

## APPLY

- Luke points out that the Sadducees denied the resurrection. (27). If our eschatology (final destiny of humanity) shapes our ethics, what do you think a worldview that says this life is all there is leads to?
- How should our hope of a resurrection cause Christians to live differently in this life?
- What are some ways we, as Christians, can daily remind ourselves of this future hope of the resurrection?

## PRAY

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
