READ

- Read Psalm 19 through a few times this week.
- Write here what you think is the main idea the author wishes to communicate:

EXAMINE

- What are the various terms the Psalmist uses to describe God's law (7-9)?
- What are the many blessings that come to those who have God's law (7-9)?
- What should the believer's attitude be toward God's law (10-11)?
- What is the Psalmist's response after meditating on God's law? What type of requests does he make when he turns to prayer (12-14)?

APPLY

- What are some examples of the ways God's law warns us? Think on some biblical examples and record and share them here.
- How has God used His word to reveal your errors, hidden faults and even secret sins?
- What is your personal attitude toward God's Word? How does this Psalm help you to delight in God's Word?
