



# THE KING'S CONFIRMATION

Luke Chapters 20-22

## READ

- In Luke 21:5-19, Jesus begins prophesying of the Temple's destruction, wars and the responsibilities of His disciples. This week continues with the destruction of Jerusalem and the coming of the Son of Man.
- Read Luke 21:20-28 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

## EXAMINE

- In verses 20-24, what are the signs and descriptions for the destruction of Jerusalem?
- What is the meaning of the titles "days of vengeance" and "times of the Gentiles"?
- In verses 25-28, what signs do we see preceding the coming of the Son of Man?
- What does Jesus instruct His disciples to do when they see the Son of Man coming?

## APPLY

- Jesus warned His disciples of the looming destruction of the Temple, Jerusalem and the people. How is His prophetic warning a blessing to His disciples? What does this tell us about God? (20-24)
- How should believers, living during these passages, view the coming of the Son of Man? What does this tell us about God? (25-28)

### Ask Yourself:

- How are the chaotic circumstances of the present world creating fear in my life?
- What am I doing today to prepare for His coming?
- Once again, we see Jesus using the Old Testament as the resource for life. How am I using the Bible to evaluate my life?

## PRAY

Dear Heavenly Father, I look forward to the day of Jesus' return in glory. Please help me to confidently trust and prepare for that day and to be ready to greet it with confidence. Lord, use me to help others prepare for your return. Until that day, help my light to shine so brightly that it draws the lost world to you. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.
