READ

EXAMINE

- What troubles are listed in verses 1-3, and how should we react to them?
 - What characteristic of God can we know through this stanza?
- How does the Psalmist describe the City of God (verses 4-6)?
 - What characteristic of God can we know through this stanza?
- What are the works of the Lord in verses 8-9?
- What command does God give in verse 10?

APPLY

- What can we know about God from this Psalm (verse 10)?
- In verses 4-6, God gives security, provision, and help to the City of God. How does He do that for us?
- Seeing the power of the Almighty in this Psalm, how are we called to change?
- Memorize the chorus of Psalm 46 (verse 11) and recite it to yourself this week.

PRAY

- P-Pray to Father God giving praise for his majesty.
- R-Repent for any disregard you have shown God this week.
- A-Ask God to help you understand His love for you.
- Y-Yield to the Lord of Hosts within us.
