



THE KING'S CONFIRMATION

Luke Chapters 20-22

READ

- This week we will be focusing on the events of the Last Supper and just before. Ask the Lord to help you as you study His Word and meditate on it.
- Read Luke 22:1-23 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- Based upon verses 1-6, what was the primary reason that the priests and scribes sought to kill Jesus? How does Judas help to advance the plan to kill Jesus?
- Why is it significant that Jesus observed the Passover? (v7-13) If Jesus had not observed the Passover, what would this have conveyed to His followers?
- In verses 14-18, what is Jesus communicating to the apostles?
- Jesus identifies Himself with the bread at the Last Supper. What was the importance of the Day of Unleavened Bread in the Old Testament (see Exodus 12:15)?
- The blood of the Passover lamb was to be placed the doors on the homes of the Israelites'. In verse 20, Jesus says there is a new covenant in His blood. How should this impact you as a servant of Christ (see Exodus 12:)?
- In verses 21-23, Jesus recognizes His betrayer is present. What does this tell us about Jesus?

APPLY

- How has the "New Covenant" changed life for us?
- What does it mean that Jesus includes us at the Lord's Supper (Communion)?
- As we take Communion this morning, how does this passage help you to recognize what Jesus has accomplished for you?

PRAY

- Praise the Lord for His love in providing His son as Passover lamb for each of us.
- Repent of any sins in your life and seek forgiveness for them.
- Ask the Lord to help you meditate on His word day and night (Joshua 1:8).
- Yield to the Lord's calling to love and serve those around you.
