



THE KING'S CONFIRMATION

Luke Chapters 20-22

READ

- Last week we studied the evening of the Last Supper. This week, we continue to look at the events of that night.
- Read Luke 22:24-38 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- In verse 24, why were the apostles in a dispute? What were they seeking?
- How does Jesus describe greatness according to Earthly terms (verse 25)?
- In verses 26-27, what is the reappearing word Jesus associates with greatness?
- In verses 28 and 29, Jesus reveals to Peter that Satan will tempt him away from Jesus for a short time. What does Peter's response tell us about him?
- (Verse 35) Jesus refers back to Luke 9:3, where the apostles were to share the gospel without provision. Now, Jesus communicates that the new mission will require some items (money, bag, and sword). For the apostles, how has the mission stayed the same and how has it changed?

APPLY

- (Verse 24) How are you seeking to be "regarded" by others?
- (Verses 26-27) Jesus left His throne to take on the role of a servant on earth. How can you take on the role of a servant?
- (Verses 31-34) How are you refusing the Word of the Lord? In what way can you prevent this?
- (Verses 35-38) How are you participating in the gospel mission? What provisions do you need?

PRAY

Pray to the Lord that He may help you to overcome self-regard, Satan's temptation, and a hostile world.
