



THE KING'S CONFIRMATION

Luke Chapters 20-22

READ

- Read Luke 22:39-53 and consider what lesson the Holy Spirit intends us to learn.

EXAMINE

- What is causing Jesus to be in so much agony during his prayer?
- What do you think Jesus' prayer teaches us about what he would soon go through on the cross?
- Why do they come to arrest Jesus in secret?
- What do we learn about Jesus when we see him heal one of those coming to arrest him?
- Look back at 22:35-38. How do you think that teaching fits in with Jesus' teaching in verses 49-53?

APPLY

- What is your greatest temptation?
- Jesus twice connects prayer and temptation (v. 40 and 46). What do you think is the relation between the two?
- Look at Jesus' prayer in verse 42: "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done." What does this teach us about how we should pray?
- They came to arrest Jesus in secret. How do you try to keep things secret?
- How can Judas' betrayal of Jesus be a warning to us?

PRAY

- Take time to praise God for who He is, confess sins, and/or make requests based on this passage.
