**What Are Equipping Classes?** The primary goal of these classes is to equip the saints to do the work of the ministry (Ephesians 4:12). ### 9:15 AM CLASSES:

**How to Study the Bible (9 weeks, August 11 - October 6) - Taught by Joe Kappel:**

At West Park, we believe that the Bible is God's truth and our sole authority and foundation for all we believe and practice. We also recognize that some parts of the Bible can be difficult to study and understand. By going through the letter to the Colossians, this equipping class will teach you how to better read, understand and apply the Bible to your own life.

**The Gospel at Work (9 weeks, October 13 - December 15) - Taught by Neal Arwood:**

What does the gospel have to do with your job? More than you think! This class will explore a Christian view of work and how being a follower of Jesus changes how we live from 9-5.

**Heart Wise 1 (18 weeks, August 11 - December 15) - Taught by Al and Terri Cage, Fred and Ruth Blevins:**

Heart Wise is a class designed to help you get to the heart of matters that are causing you to struggle with things such as anxiety, depression, and conflict in marital, familial, and other relationships. Truths highlighted in this class will equip all believers to apply godly principles and find hope in every circumstance of life.

**Love Like You Mean It: The Heart of Marriage That Honors God (18 weeks, August 11 - December 15) - Taught by Rich and Maggie McKinney:**

Do patience, kindness, trust, and hope characterize your marriage? This class is relevant to married couples of all ages and stages as we consider how each attribute of God-honoring love described in 1 Corinthians 13 can be lived out in our relationships. With biblical love as our foundation, we'll also be equipped with practical guidance for how to better handle our time, money, communication, conflicts, intimacy, and ministry in God-honoring ways.

**Engaging the World (18 weeks, August 11 - December 15) - Taught by Paul Wehmeier and Jeff Wiggs:**

As followers of Jesus, the gospel should affect every aspect of our lives. Join us to learn how to live out and share the gospel in the places God has commissioned you.

### 11:00 AM CLASSES:

**Wisdom for Life (18 weeks, August 11 - December 15) - Taught by James Lynch:**

This study will focus on the wisdom books of the Old Testament Scriptures. Our goal will be to seek God's inspired wisdom to guide us as we follow Him in our daily lives.
